ORDINANCE 2017-1 - TOWN OF CHILTON CALUMET COUNTY, WISCONSIN

AN ORDINANCE TO OPERATE GOLF CARTS ON PUBLIC ROADS WITHIN THE TOWN OF CHILTON

Be it hereby ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Chilton, Calumet County, Wisconsin, that pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 349.18(1)(b) golf carts can use Town roads designated by the Town Board.

The following road in the Town of Chilton is open to golf cart use: "Fairway Drive".

Golf Cart: Shall mean a vehicle whose speed attainable in one mile does not exceed 20 miles per hour on a paved, level surface, and that is designed and intended to convey one or more persons and equipment to play the game of golf in an area designated as a golf course.

Requirements: No person may operate a golf cart on a public street unless it conforms to all federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

In order to be used on approved roadways within the Town of Chilton the operator must have a valid drivers' license.

The Town of Chilton shall procure, erect and maintain appropriate signage approved by the Department of Transportation to mark the golf cart travel route by the ordinance.

Effective Date: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
